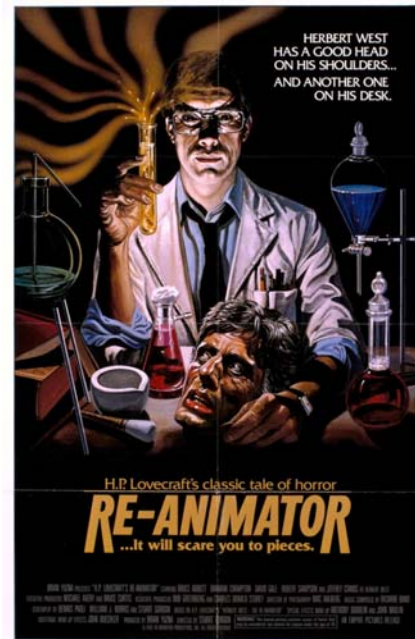

The Rise of the Mall

- Started in California in the 1920's with stores connected to a grocery store
- First enclosed mall was in Minneapolis suburbs, 1956
- Intended to be a social, community center
- Shopping mall named as "top 50 wonders that revolutionized the lives of consumers" (Consumer Reports, 1986)
