# The Change

## § 102(b) (pre-AIA)

### Conditions for patentability; novelty and loss of right of patent.

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States

## § 102(a)(1) (post-AIA)

### Conditions for patentability; novelty

(a) **Novelty; Prior Art** – A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(1) the claimed invention was patented, described in a printed publication, or in public use, on sale, or otherwise available to the public before the effective filing date of the claimed invention

### § 102(b) (pre-AIA)

#### Conditions for patentability; novelty and loss of right of patent.

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(b) the *invention* was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale *in this country, more than one year prior* to the *date of application* for patent in the United States

### § 102(a)(1) (post-AIA)

#### Conditions for patentability; novelty

(a) **Novelty; Prior Art** – A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(1) the *claimed invention* was patented, described in a printed publication, or in public use, on sale, or otherwise available to the public *before* the *effective filing date* of the claimed invention
