## The Change

§ 102(b) (pre-AIA) Conditions for patentability; novelty and loss of right of patent.

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or *in public use* or *on sale* in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States

§ 102(a)(1) (post-AIA)

Conditions for patentability; novelty

- (a) **Novelty; Prior Art** A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –
- (1) the claimed invention was patented, described in a printed publication, or *in public use*, *on sale*, or *otherwise available to the public* before the effective filing date of the claimed invention

## The Change

§ 102(b) (pre-AIA) Conditions for patentability; novelty and loss of right of patent.

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(b) the <u>invention</u> was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale <u>in this country</u>, <u>more than one year prior</u> to the <u>date of application</u> for patent in the United States

§ 102(a)(1) (post-AIA)
Conditions for patentability; novelty

(a) **Novelty; Prior Art** – A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(1) the <u>claimed invention</u> was patented, described in a printed publication, or in public use, on sale, or otherwise available to the public <u>before</u> the <u>effective filing date</u> of the claimed invention
