



The Numbers	
Number of trial courts:	1 Federal +all provincial superior courts
Number of annual patent infringement litigation filings:	73
Percentage of cases that go to trial:	6%
Average time to trial:	24-36 months
Patentee win rate:	47%
Validity win rate:	40%
Statute of limitations:	6 years from the date of infringement



Filing Suit Provincial or federal court Majority are filed in federal court The Federal Court of Canada does not have any specific geographic location No jurisdictional differences between the courts Decisions of the Federal Court are binding in every province and territory in Canada
