



## Educator Code of Ethics Pmbl: The Texas educator shall comply with standard practices and ethical conduct toward students, professional colleagues, school officials, parents, and *members of the community* and shall safeguard academic freedom. The Texas educator, in maintaining the dignity of the profession, shall respect and obey the law, demonstrate personal integrity, and exemplify honesty. Standard 1.10: "The educator shall be of good moral character and be worthy to instruct or supervise the youth of this state."





## "Unworthy to instruct or to supervise the youth of this state"

- 19 Tex. Admin. Code § 249.3(59).
- Absence of those moral, mental, and psychological qualities that are required to enable an educator to render the service essential to the accomplishment of the goals and mission of the State Board for Educator Certification policy and Chapter 247 of this title (relating to Educators' Code of Ethics). ... A determination that a person is unworthy to instruct does not require a criminal conviction.
