USC's

2nd preference:
Spouses/minor
children-LPR's
2B:unmarried
children<21

3rd preference:
Married
children-USC's

4th preference:
Brothers and
Sisters of USC's

- Unmarried children under 21 of USC's>>>>



- Parents of USC's >>



Priority Dates

Priority dates are assigned to each application based on the date that the application was received by the USCIS
