Hire American Buy American Executive Order

- Directs the DHS to coordinate with other agencies, to ensure H-1B visas are awarded to the most-skilled or highest paid beneficiaries.
- Enhanced the current site visit program to include L-1B, in addition to H-1B and L-1.
- Created streamline process for the public to report fraud.
- Enhanced information sharing between different agencies, DOS, DOL, DOJ. See MOU of May 11, 2018.

Statistics on Requests for evidence & denials

- Per the July 2018 issue of the National Foundation for American Policy, RFEs and denials have spiked.
- The number of H-1B RFEs in the 4th quarter of FY 2017 almost equaled the total number of RFEs issued for the first 3 quarters of 2017 combined.
- H-1B denials were increased by 41% from the 3rd to 4th quarter of FY 2017, rising from a denial rate of 15.9% in the 3rd quarter to 22.4% in the 4th quarter.
- And then - Policy Memo on discretion to deny without an RFE.

30/60/90 Day Rule & Misrepresentation

- B1/B2
- Managers/executives entering for meetings, interrogated by CBP regarding purpose of the meeting.
- Turned back, told by CBP to get an L.
- Documenting interactions with other agencies.
- Inconsistent conduct within 90 days: 9 FAM 302.9-4 (B)(3)g(2)
- Misrepresentation: 9 FAM 302.9-4 (B)(3)
