## **LAW**

#### • Elimination of Architectural Barriers 469.101

- The law requires review and approval of plans and specific ations for new construction and substantial alterations for, Buildings or facilities subject to the law with,
- An estimated construction cost of \$50,000 or more.
  - o Alteration Are novation, modification, or change to a building or facility that affects or could affect the usability of the building or facility or portion thereof. Re-roofing, painting, or wallpapering, or changes to mechanical and electrical systems are not alterations unless they affect the usability of the building or facility. 68.10(2)
  - o Estimated Construction Cost Includes all costs for construction of a project except site acquisition, are hitectural, engineering and consulting fees, furniture, and equipment unless the equipment is part of the mechanical, electrical, or plumbing systems. 68.10(13)

 $\underline{\text{No te}}$  -  $\underline{\text{Te}}$  xas law is a construction law and not a civil rights law like the ADA.
