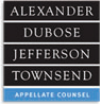

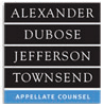

1. Fact Strategy

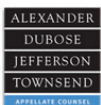
- ▶ Discovery, evidence, the story

Fact Strategy

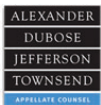
- ▶ Principal audience: the jury

2. Law Strategy

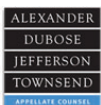
- ▶ Principal audience: the judge
