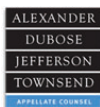

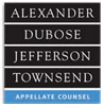
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Two parts to every case:

1. Fact Strategy

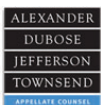
- Discovery, evidence, the story



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Fact Strategy

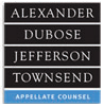
- Principal audience: the jury



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2. Law Strategy

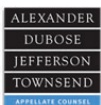
► Principal audience: the judge
