- Educate with specialized knowledge
- Assist by providing independent analysis and opinions
- Help the judge or jury understand the evidence

THE SUPREME COURT CREATED THE BASIC EXPERT RULES

- *Daubert*, *Kuhmo*, and *Joiner*
- *Daubert* Applies in Bankruptcy Court
- The Judge is the “gatekeeper”

THE FRE FLESHES OUT THE SUPREME COURT’S HOLDINGS

- FRE 702 – Puts *Daubert* into Practice
- FRE 703 – Experts Can Use Hearsay in Forming Opinions
- FRE 704 – Experts Can Opine on Who Wins
- FRE 705 – Testimony Doesn’t Need to Be Mind-Numbing
