Regional Centralization of SSI Trust Review Process

- Social Security Administration implemented business process on April 28, 2014
- Process centralizes reviews by region(s)
- Goals: improve quality, accurate and consistent trust determinations, strengthen proficiency of FO employee, and capture management information
- FO technician makes initial trust determination; RTRT reviews determination prior to case effectuation
- Post-eligibility Events & subsequent reviews

Key Players and Their RolesField Office Technician

- First point of contact
- Makes initial and reconsideration trust resource determinations
- Submits determinations to the RTRT for review
- Effectuates trust resource determinations
