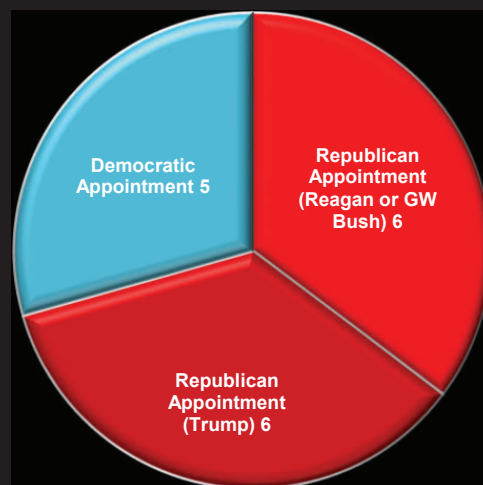

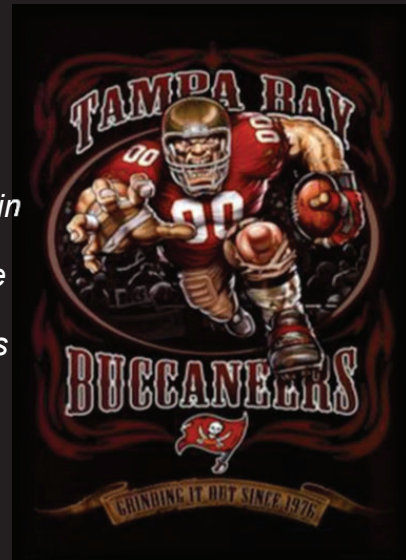

920 F.3d 209 (5th Cir. 2019)

Clause: “. . .if any dispute arises with respect to either Party’s **performance**.”

Dispute: “. . . a dispute related to the **interpretation** of the Agreement, not a performance-related dispute....”
