# BURDENS OF PROOF

## MOTION TO LIFT THE AUTOMATIC STAY

- 11 U.S.C. § 362(g)
- *“In any hearing under subsection (d) or (e) of this section concerning relief from the stay of any act under subsection (a) of this section—*
  - *(1) the party requesting such relief has the burden of proof on the issue of the debtor’s equity in property; and*
  - *(2) the party opposing such relief has the burden of proof on all other issues.”*
