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## **Permian Basin Pricing**

- Permian focus
  - Production of associated gas
  - 9.5 10 Bcf/d
  - Severe transportation constraints
- Pricing at Waha
  - From \$0/MMBtu to -\$5/MMBtu in 2019
  - \$8/MMbtu discount to Henry Hub
  - Some price stability from curtailed production
  - New stability from imminent takeaway capacity (GCX)
    - From \$8 delta to Henry Hub to \$0.59 in September (averaging \$2 \$3)


