## Buyer’s proposed draft of “accuracy of representations” condition:

*Each of* Target’s representations and warranties is accurate *in all material respects* as of the date of this agreement, and will be accurate *in all material respects* as of the closing date....

## Target company’s proposed draft of “accuracy of representations” condition:

Target’s representations and warranties are accurate as of the date of this agreement and will be accurate as of the closing date, *except that this condition will be deemed satisfied if all inaccuracies in Target’s representations and warranties do not collectively give rise to a Material Adverse Effect on Target or its business.....*
