B-1/B-2 Visitor Visa - Overview



- **Purpose:** Short term visits
- **Procedure:** Apply at U.S. Consulate
- **Validity:** Up to 10 years
- **Limitations:**
 - Must not engage in employment in U.S.
 - Must not be paid U.S. salary
 - **Non**-immigrant intent required
 - Admission: up to 6 months
 - COS and EOS possible
- **9 FAM 402.2**

Visa Waiver Program (ESTA)

- Entry without visa for citizens of 38 countries
- Apply for travel authorization through ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) at least 72 hours before departure
- Admitted as WT (Tourist) or WB (Business)
- B-Visa Limitations
- Admission for 90 days
- **No** COS or EOS
