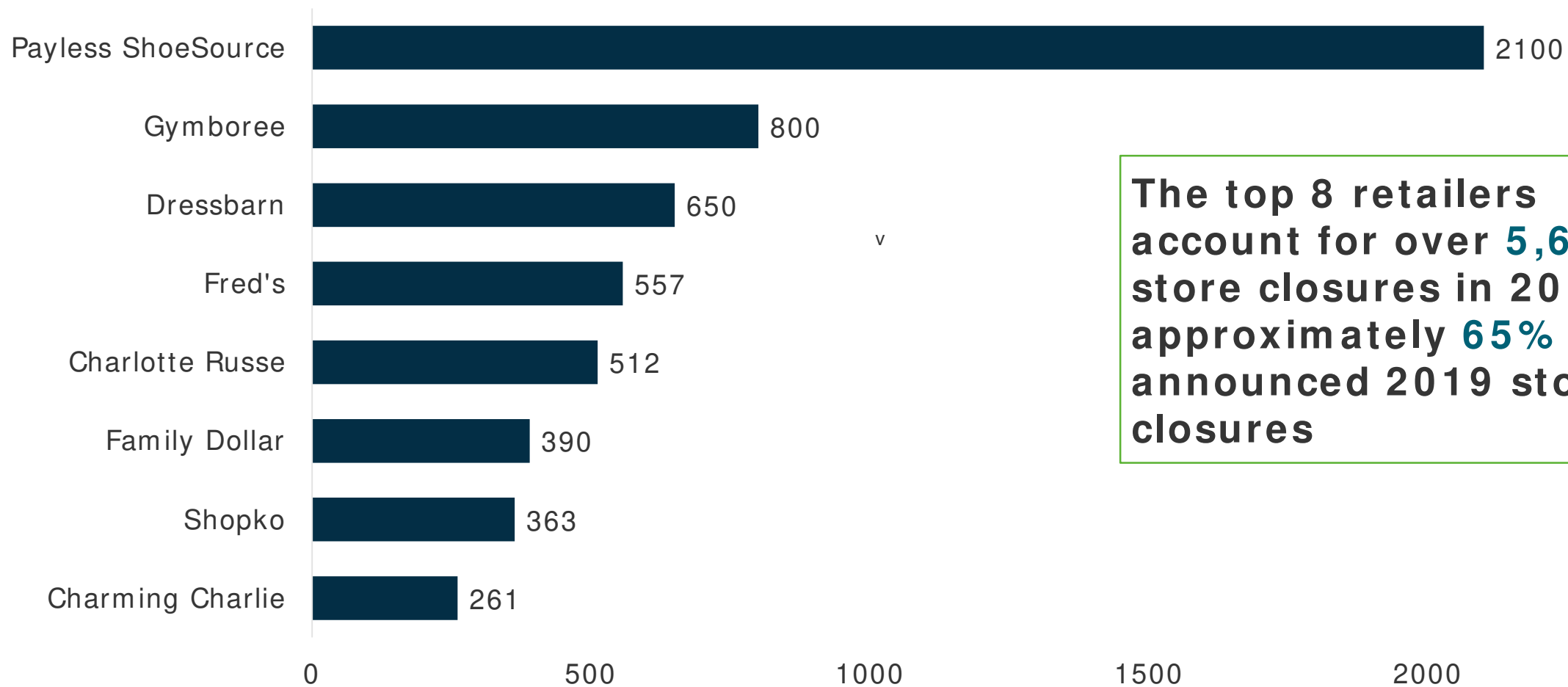

2019 “Big Name” Store Closures



The top 8 retailers account for over 5,600 store closures in 2019, approximately 65% of announced 2019 store closures

The retail world is rapidly changing as consumers shift behavior leading to a record amount of store closures

2018 Store Closures by Retail Sector



In 2018 there were 8,000 store closures, but 8,000 more have been announced for 2019 and up to 12,000 are expected by year-end.
