SSDI & SSI

Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)

- Monthly cash benefit
- Medicare
- Not Means Tested



Can be eligible for both

Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

- Monthly cash benefit
- Medicaid
- Means Tested

SSI Eligibility Requirements

Categorical: Disability, 65+, Blindness

Alienage: Ineligible except certain groups such as:

- Citizens & aliens entering before 8/22/96
- Asylees and refugees
- Veteran or on active duty in the armed services

Income Limits:

• \$783/mo. individual, \$1,175/mo. couple; first \$20 exempt

Resources Limits:

- \$2,000 individual, \$3,000 couple; residence & other exemptions
- Who receives? No/ little work history
