- Harmless error

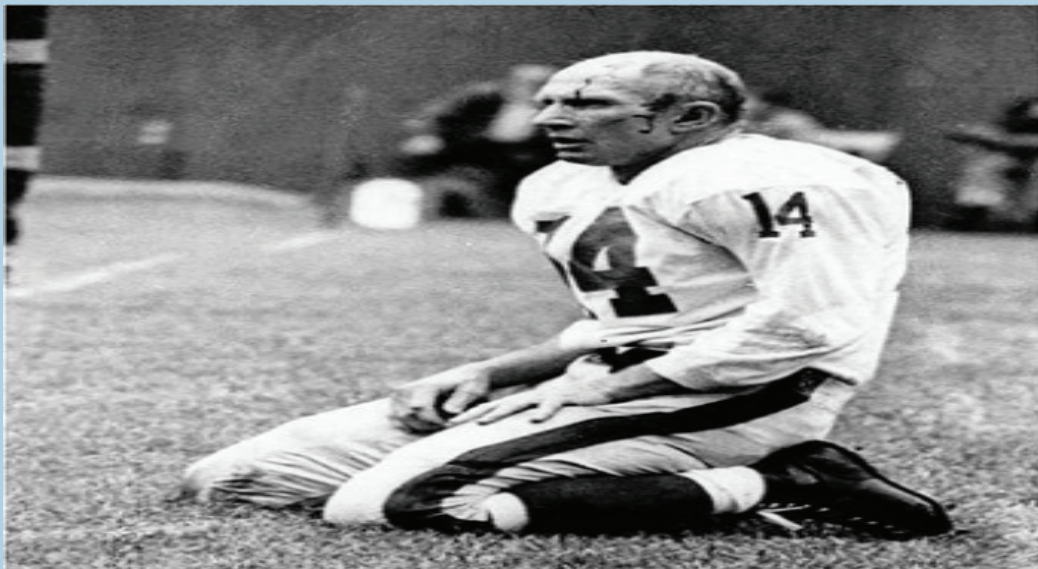
