3. With a little thought, examining a witness is almost as easy.

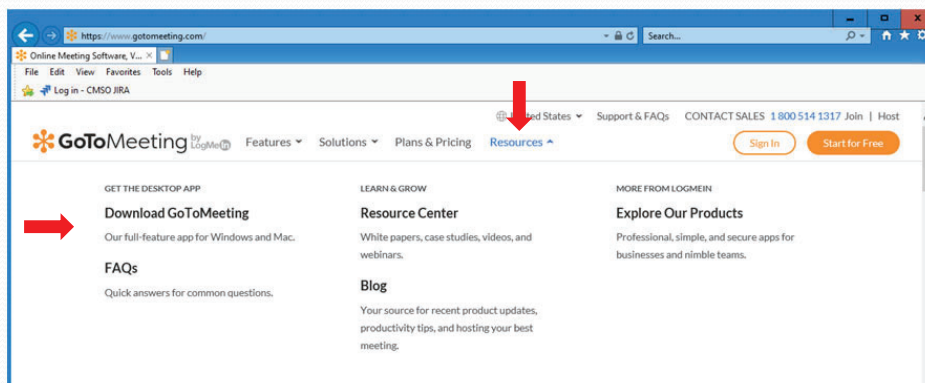


