European Patent System

- Separate National patents in each country
- European Patent Convention
 - 38 member states, + 6 extension/validation states
 - Not to be confused with the European Union (27 Countries)
 - operated by European Patent Organisation and its regional patent office:
 - Central examination of applications + 3rd party opposition
 - Granted EPC patent results in bundle of national patents (or your choosing)
 - · Can be more cost effective than separate filings
 - · Granted cases litigation subject to national and EU law
 - Attempts to establish Unitary Patent and Unified Patent Court for EU is still ongoing

 - **≻**Inventions
 - > there are also Design Rights under national or EU law
- Four ways of filing
 - **➤** Direct filing
 - **▶** Paris convention filing
 - **≻PCT filing designating EPO**
 - > PCT filing designating countries
