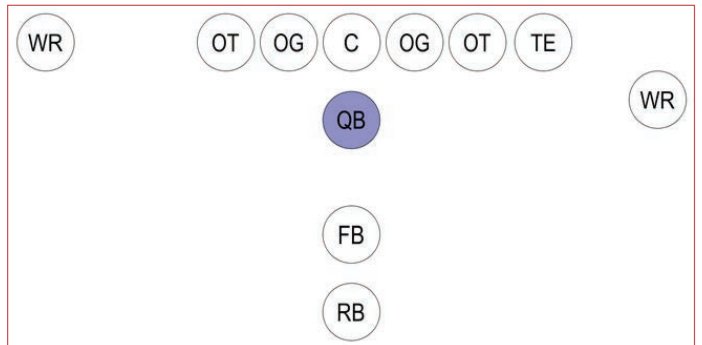

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TEXAS

- **Definition of a Breach:** Unauthorized **acquisition/exfiltration** of *sensitive personal information* that was not encrypted. This only applies to computerized data.
- **Definition of Sensitive Personal Information:**
 - An individual's first name (or first initial) **and** last name in combination with one or more of the following:
 - Social Security number;
 - Driver's license number or other government-issued identification number
 - Account number or credit or debit card number in combination with any required security code, access code, or password that would permit access to an individual's financial account; and
 - Information that relates to the physical or mental health or condition of the individual, the provision of healthcare to the individual, or payment for the provision of healthcare to the individual
- **Notice to Affected Individuals:** Notice to individuals should be made without unreasonable delay and no later than the 60th day after it's determined that the breach occurred.
- **Notice to TX AG:** Notice is required if more than 250 individuals require notice.

There are more threat actor groups and some groups are splitting, leading to re-extortion.
