Discretionary Denials

Discretionary denials versus getting to the merits.

- Fintiv: deny review because of jury trial
- Valve and General Plastic: deny review because of earlier petitions

Fintiv "discretionary denial" factors

(Apple Inc. v. Fintiv, Inc., IPR 2020-00019, Mar. 20, 2020)

- District court stay
- District court trial date
- "Investment" in district court proceeding
- Overlap of issues
- Same party
- Merits
