### Why, What, Who & Where Title Standards?

**Why:** To alleviate disagreements among title examiners by setting forth standards on which title examiners can generally agree to promote uniformity.

**What:** Statements that declare an answer to a question or a solution to a problem, commonly encountered in title examination.
