# Landmark Case: Aerospatiale

"It is well settled that [foreign] statutes do not deprive an American court of the power to order a party subject to its jurisdiction to produce evidence even though the act of production may violate that statute."

Societe Nationale Industrielle Aerospatiale v. U.S. Dist. Ct. for S. Dist. of Iowa, 482, U.S. 522, 544 n.29 (1987).

## **Balancing Test**

- Aerospatiale led to development of a balancing test
- Five non-exhaustive factors

Importance to the litigation of the documents requested

Degree of specificity of the request

Whether the information originated in the United States

Availability of alternative means of securing the information

Extent to which noncompliance with the request would undermine important interests of the U.S., or compliance would undermine important interests of nation where information is located
