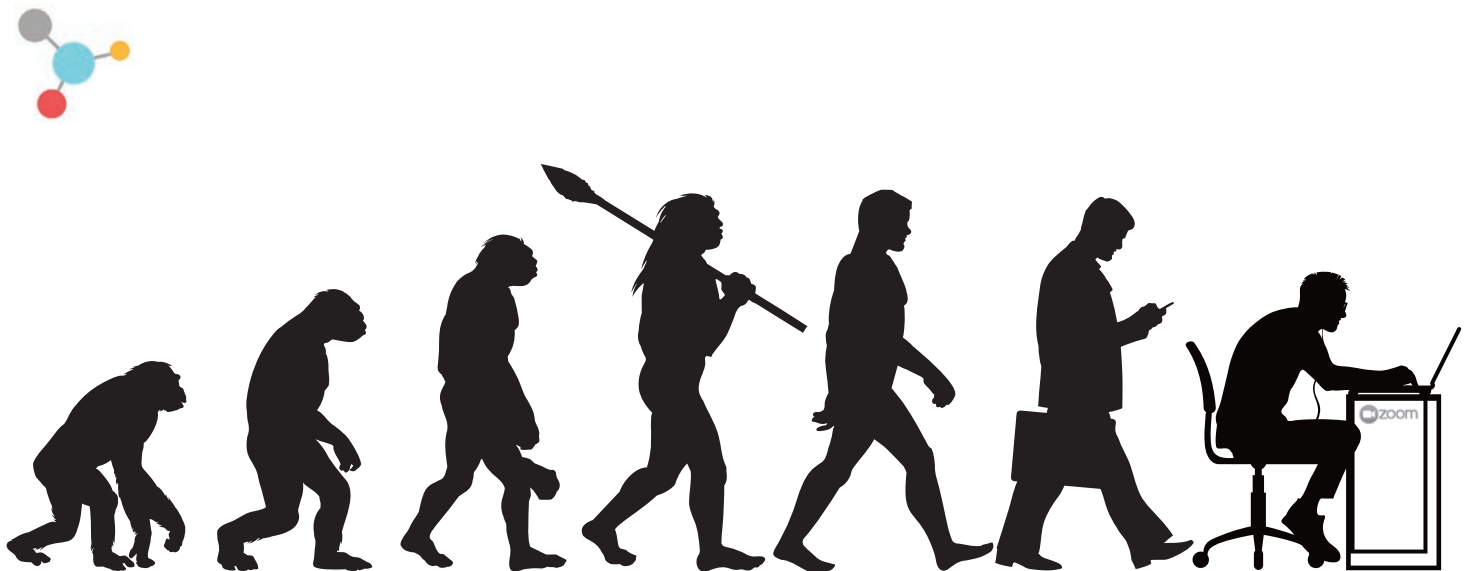

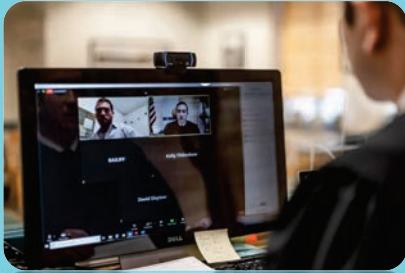

- Your fear is legitimate



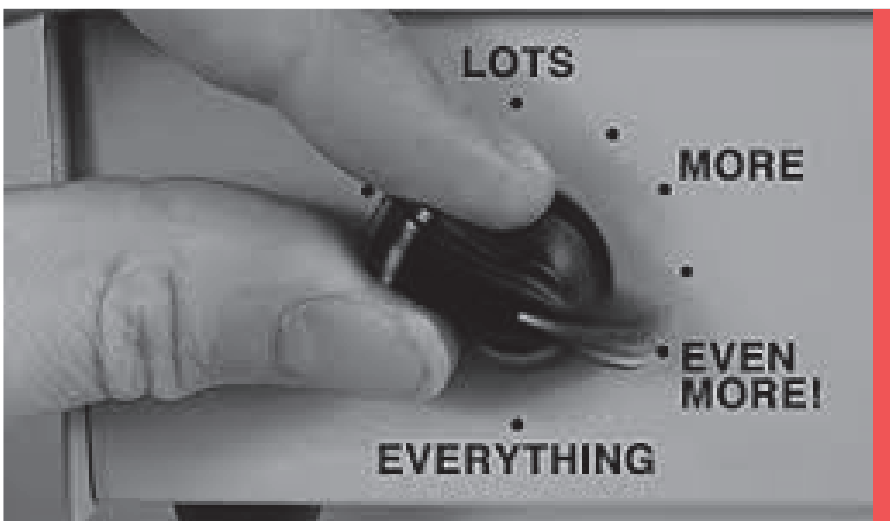
## Misconceptions When Conducting Remote Proceedings
