
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State Law Updates



State Privacy Laws

Unfair and Deceptive Acts and Practices Laws	 Gives State Attorneys General authority to prevent unfa
(State FTC-like laws)	deceptive acts and practices
Data Security Breach Notification Laws	 Generally require entities that experience a data breach
(all states)	provide notification to authorities and/or individuals
Data Destruction/Disposal Laws	 Generally require entities to destroy or dispose of perso
(Approx. 36 states)	information in a secure manner
Data Security Laws	 Generally require entities to use reasonable security
(Approx. 27 states)	standards to safeguard the personal information
Biometric Privacy Laws (Approx. nine states)	 Requirements regarding the collection, use, and sharing biometric data from individuals
"Comprehensive" Privacy Laws (Two or four* states)	See GDPR/CCPA/CDPA
Data Broker Laws (Two states)	 Requirements for "data brokers" regarding disclosure, consent and opt out
