

Key rules to know for effective error preservation



Constitutionalize objections



TRAP 44.2(a) v. 44.2(b)

Constitutional error - Must reverse unless determine BRD error did not contribute to conviction/punishment.

Any other error that does not affect substantial rights must be disregarded.
