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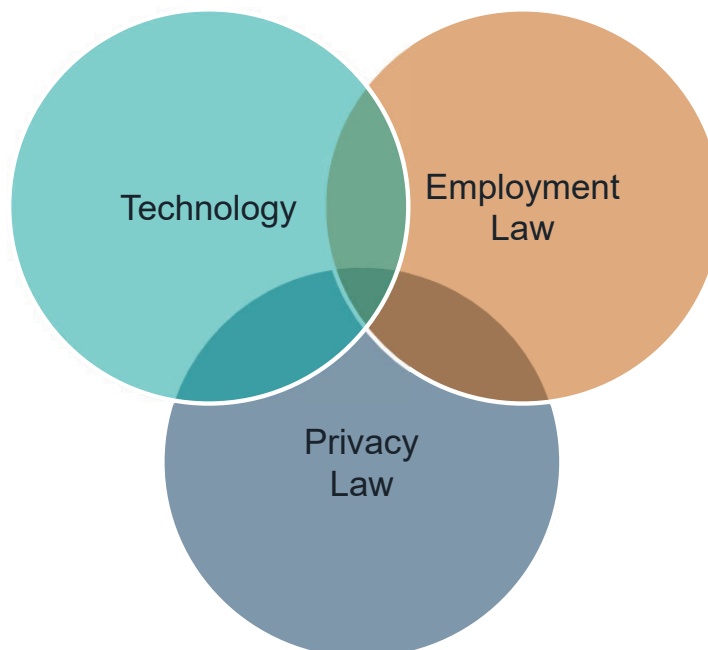
Scope of Discussion: Monitoring in the Workplace

- Corporate network usage
 - Internet usage on corporate system
 - E-mail usage – corporate and personal, on corporate system
 - CCTV
 - Employee-owned devices / BYOD
 - Location tracking
 - AI and other advanced technologies
- Generally speaking, the scope of discussion here relates to live monitoring and not to forensics to ascertain activity after the fact.

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Real-time Screen Monitoring

Whenever you want to check what your employees are doing, you can use real-time screen monitoring. You can easily see the world through your employees' eyes.

Watch Multiple Screens Simultaneous

SurveilStar allows you to watch multiple screens simultaneous, 2*2, 3*3 and 4*4 are supported. You can monitor up to 16 screens at the same time.

Record Screenshots for Future Review

By default, SurveilStar doesn't take screen snapshots. However, you can create a Screen Monitoring policy to record screen snapshots and you can replay it like a video later. Default interval is 15 seconds, and it's up to you to set more or less frequently.

Export as Picture or Video

You can save the real-time screenshot as individual *.jpg or *.bmp picture, or export the recorded snapshots as *.wmv video file.
