

Affirmation / After Acquired Evidence
Background check authorization



THE INTERVIEW NOTES

- AVOID PHYSICAL DESCRIPTIONS TO REMEMBER CANDIDATES
- FOCUS ON QUALITIES OF PROMISING CANDIDATES



THE OFFER LETTER

- At Will Status / No oral contracts to the contrary.
- Contingencies (drug testing, background check, signing NDA)
- Initial Position & Compensation
- Benefits subject to change
- Relocation reimbursement (cap)



THE OFFER LETTER

- By signing, employee represents that acceptance of the position doesn't violate a commitment to a prior employer.
- Employee is not to share any confidential or trade secret information from prior employers.
- No prior representations or promises
