## **Bankruptcy Courts**

U.S. Const. art. I § 8: "The Congress shall have the power to . . . establish . . . uniform laws on the subject of bankruptcies throughout the United States."

Article I v. Article III Judges. Bankruptcy courts function as a unit of the district courts—bankruptcy cases are automatically referred to bankruptcy courts.

Appeals generally go first to the District Court then to the Fifth Circuit.






