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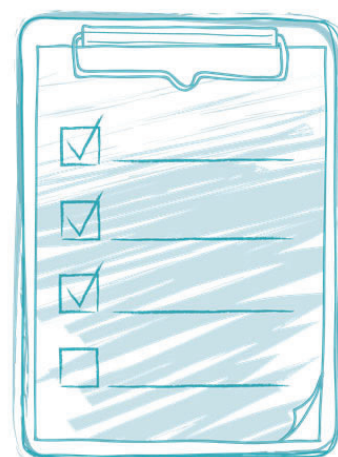

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White House

- President Biden
 - March 1 State of the Union Address
 - Pass the PRO Act
 - Pass the Paycheck Fairness Act
 - Raise the minimum wage to \$15 hour
 - Pass the Equality Act
 - Pass paid family and medical leave legislation
- Increasing shift to state and local workplace regulation



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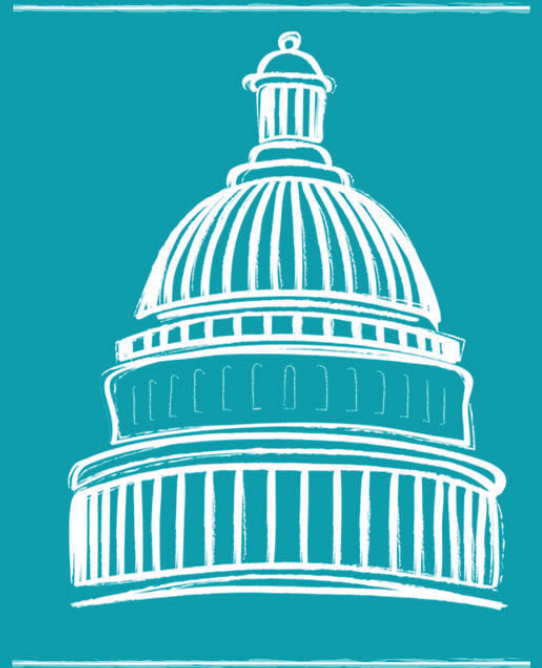
