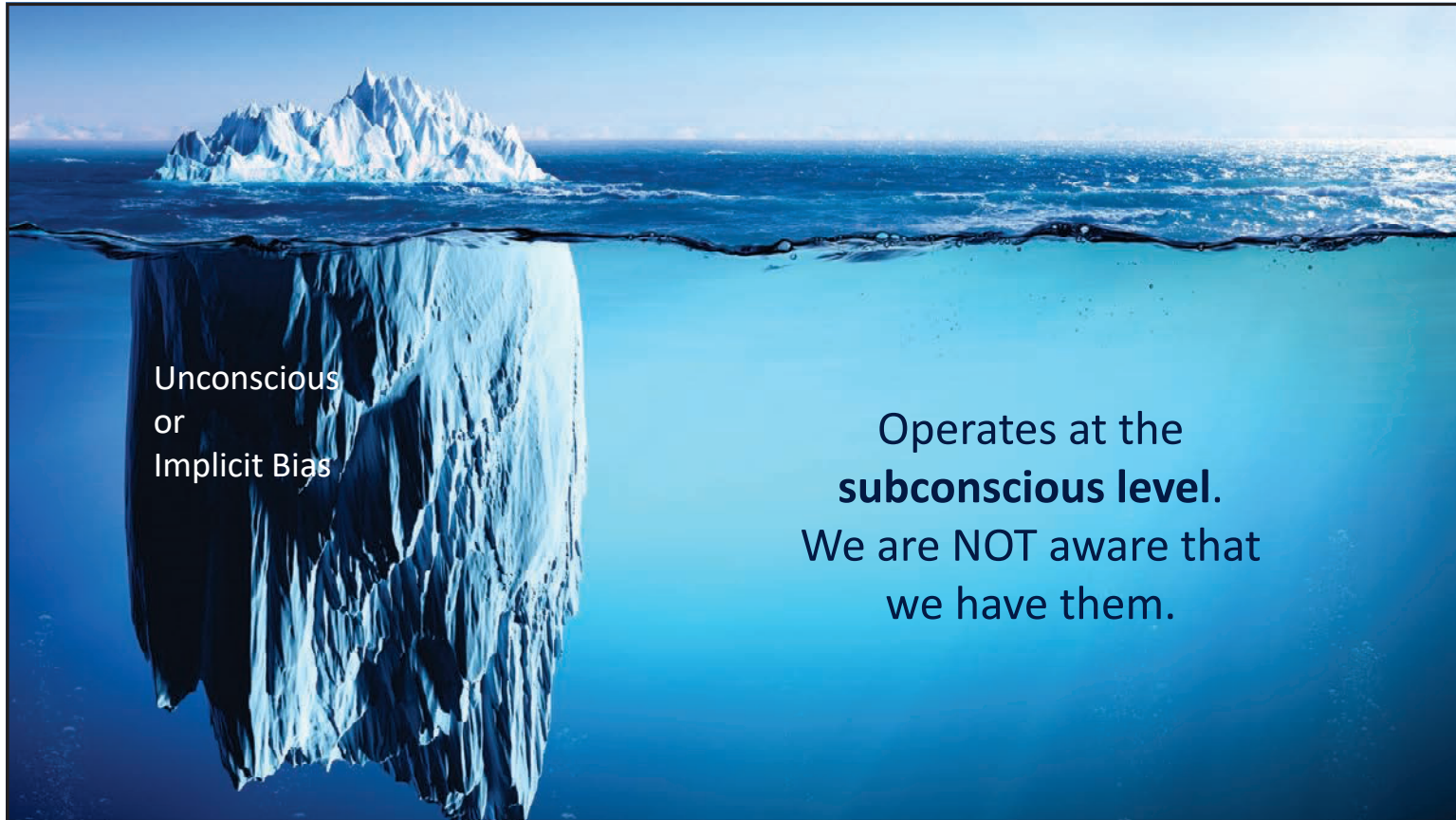
Explicit Bias

- Deliberate
- Conscious
- Easy to self-recognize
- Social and personal values
- Systematic prejudice and/or discrimination

Implicit Bias

- Typically Unconscious
- Involuntarily formed
- Habit
- Cryptic response
- “Micro-aggressions”

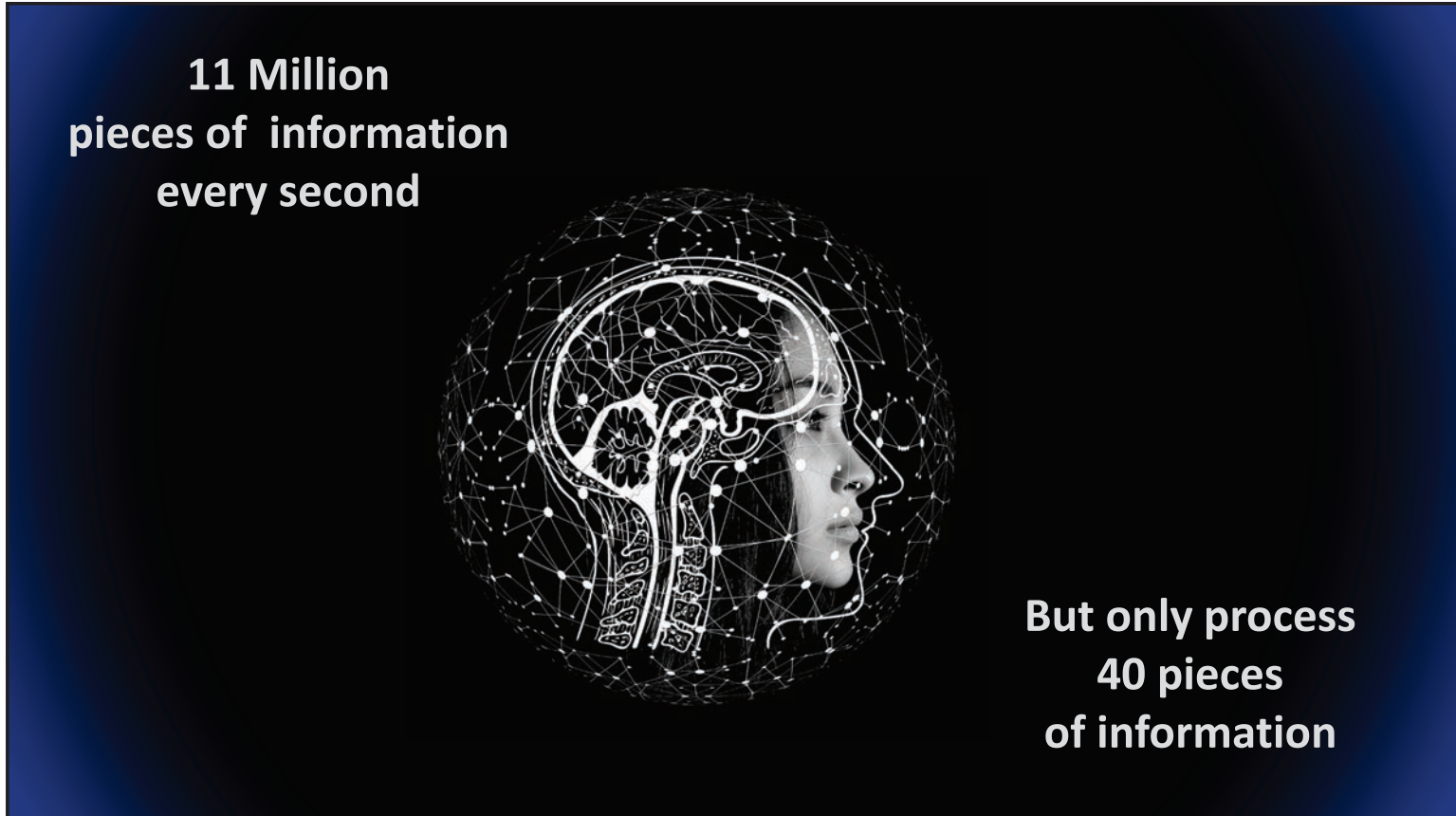
