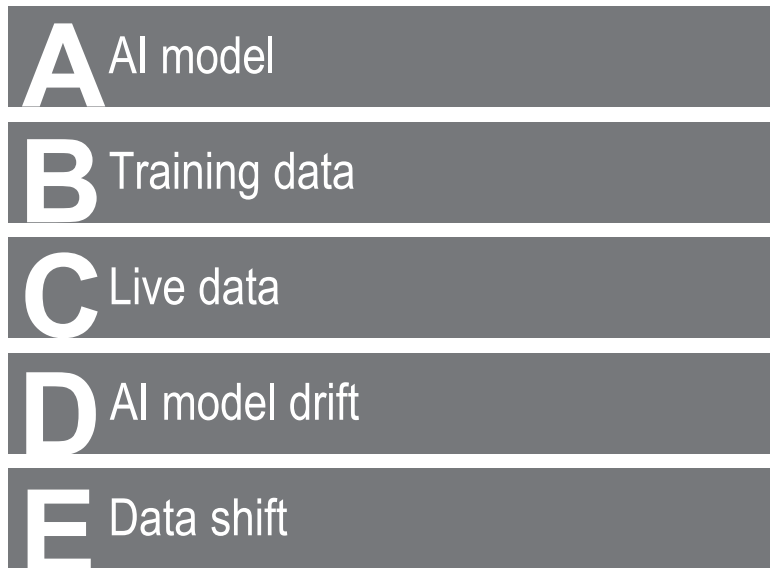

Example use cases

Across all of your cases

Privilege

Build more robust privilege models with examples from across cases

Contracts and other “classifiers”

Automatically sort documents with specific characteristics

Junk

Cull spam and clearly irrelevant documents at the beginning of a case

For specific practice areas

Patent IP

Automatically identify documents related to clinical trials or a certain pharmaceutical

FCPA

Create models for common issues (kickbacks, corruption) or geographies (Russia, France)

Employment

Create models for issues in common claims like discrimination or harassment
