Elements of Asylum

- Past persecution OR well-founded fear of persecution
- Nexus ("on account of")
- Protected Ground
 - Race, Religion, Nationality, Membership in a particular social group (PSG),
 Political opinion
- Committed by government OR someone the government is unwilling or una to control
- Internal relocation not reasonable
- •No bars to eligibility
