## *The Initial Consultation*

- Potential Client Calls the Office to request an appointment.
- Assistant asks basic questions to find out what the case is about.
- Based on information gathered during initial screening, determine if we offer the appointment and the amount of time allotted for that particular appointment.



## *Common Questions during a consultation:*

- Can I fix my papers?
- Am I going to have to leave the country?
- Will I be punished for 10 years?
- Am I going to get a work permit while I wait for my appointment?
- What happens if I need a waiver?
