How and when to work with a criminal defense attorney?

□ As soon as possible!


- Ask about pre-trial diversion programs (where pleas are not required) early as there are enrollment deadlines
- Reach out to Padilla experts if you need help identifying possible alternate/safe pleas.

Set your expectations

- Reduction or dismissal often not available
- Non-detained criminal cases move slowly
- Going to trial can be a very big risk, as Texas has broad sentencing range



How a case moves in criminal court



Reminder of Defense Counsel Duties



 Padilla requires defense counsel to give detailed and specific advice

□ Not a general admonition

- □ Not just referring the client to immigration counsel
 - Defense counsel needs to talk to immigration counsel

Important Texas Criminal Court Terminology

- Deferred Adjudication
 - Is a conviction but the period on deferred is not a sentence
- **Straight Probation**
 - \square Is a conviction and the suspended sentence is a sentence (2/5)
- □ Pre-Trial Diversion
 - Must look at the diversion contract to see if plea or admission
- □ SAFPF
 - " "rehabilitation" that counts as a sentence
