

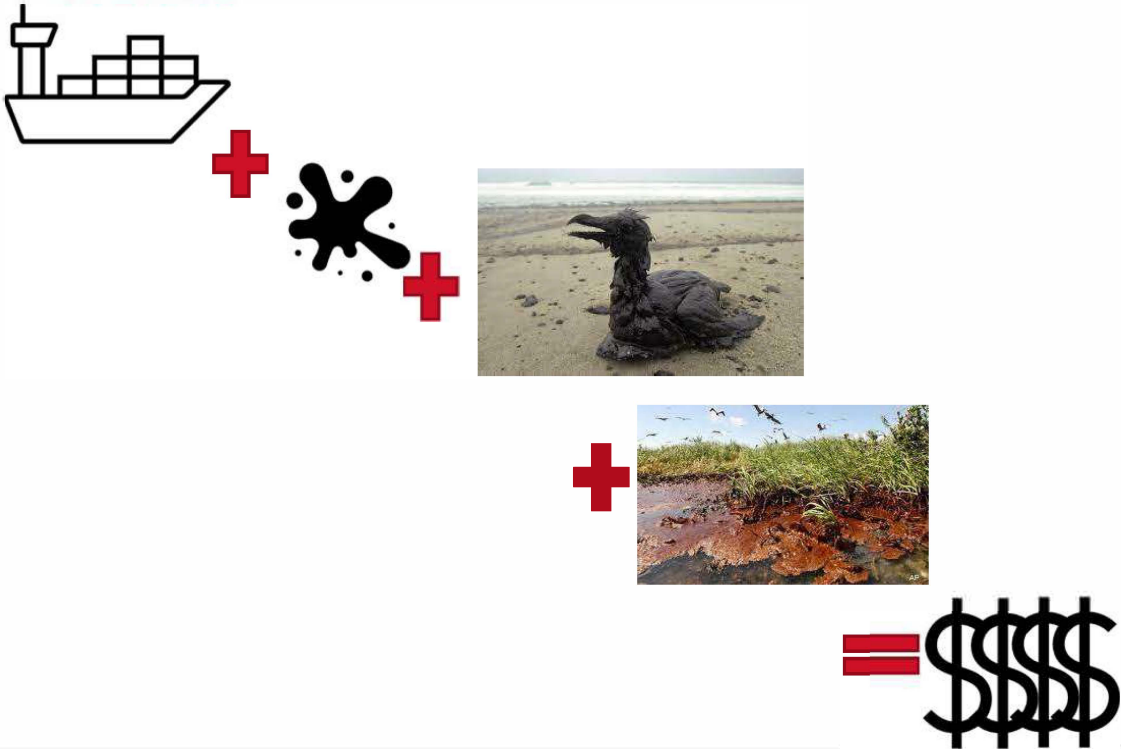

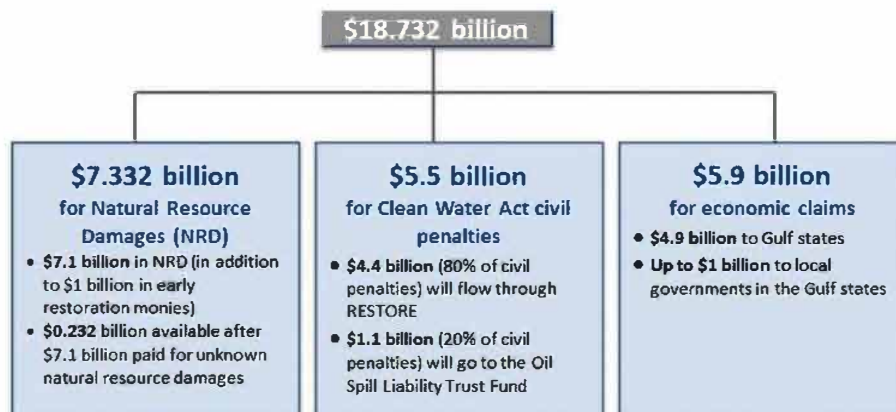

Statutory Penalties Are Adjusted for Inflation

Statutory Provision	Penalty When Enacted	Current Penalty
Oil Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. § 2716a)	\$25,000/day	\$51,796/day (30 C.F.R. § 553.51)
Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. § 1319(d))	\$25,000/day	\$59,973/day (40 C.F.R. § 19.4)
Marine Protection, Research, and Sanctuaries Act (33 U.S.C. § 1415(a))	\$50,000/violation	\$218,048/violation (40 C.F.R. § 19.4)
Endangered Species Act (16 U.S.C. § 1540(a)(1))	\$25,000/knowning violation	\$57,527/knowning violation (50 C.F.R. § 11.33)
Marine Mammal Protection Act (16 U.S.C. § 1375)	\$10,000/violation or \$20,000/knowning violation	\$29,074/any violation (50 C.F.R. § 11.33)
CERCLA (42 U.S.C. § 9604(e)(5)(B))	\$25,000/day	\$62,689/day (40 C.F.R. § 19.4)
