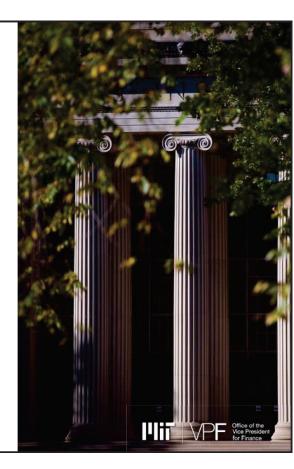

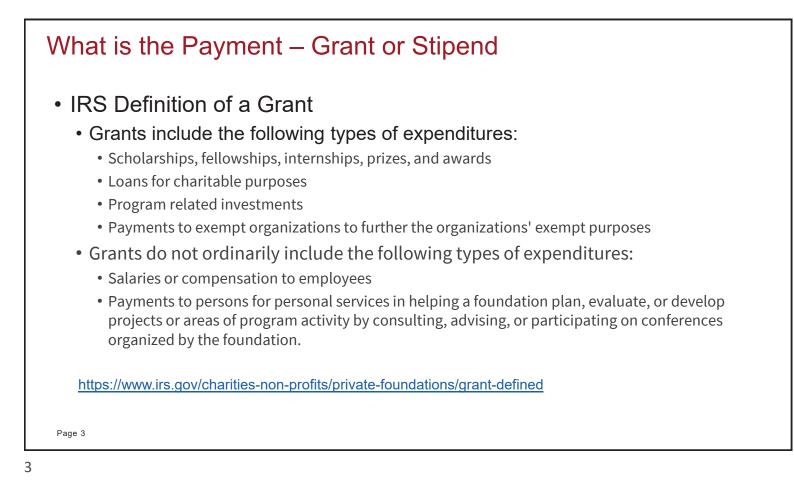

What is the Payment – Grant or Stipend
<ul> <li>Stipend – A form of compensation that is paid to certain individuals for services rendered, other work, or while they receive training</li> <li>The IRS does not have a definition for Stipend. This definition is from Investopedia</li> </ul>
The Institution must determine what is actually being paid and withhold taxes and report the payment accordingly

What is the Payment – Scholarship or Fellowship
<ul> <li>Scholarship – An amount paid or allowed to a student at an educational institution for the purpose of study</li> <li>Student</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Fellowship – An amount paid or allowed to an individual for the purpose of study or research</li> </ul>

What is the Payment – Scholarship or Fellowship (Cont.)
<ul> <li>IRS Guidance:</li> <li>Qualified scholarships = tuition, fees, books, supplies and equipment required for enrollment or attendance of course at an educational organization</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Nonqualified scholarships = scholarship/ fellowship payment not meeting the definition above (e.g. scholarship funds used for room and board)</li> </ul>
