



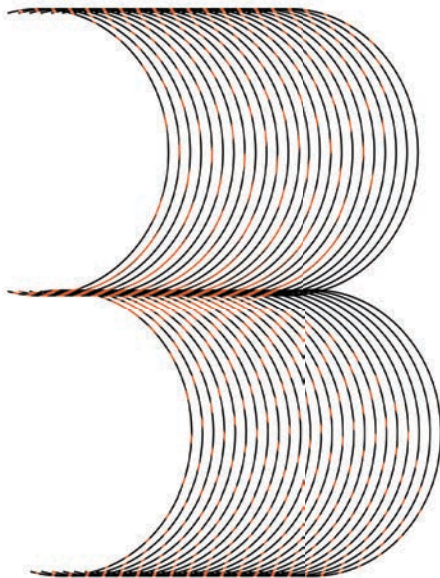
Start Early!

Pre-trial Conference

- Charge is appropriate for discussion per Rule 166a(k)
- Proposed charge: Most courts require you to file pretrial
