
Mechanics of Ex Parte Reexaminations

What is an ex parte reexamination?

- •USPTO reexamines the patentability of challenged claims of an issued patent based on prior art patents and printed publications
 - -Panel of three examiners in the Central Reexamination Unit (CRU)
- Requester
 - -Third-party challenger
 - -Patent Owner
 - -Director
- Ex parte proceeding
 - –Limited input from a third-party challenger



Why use a reexamination post-AIA?




