Since June 1, 2023, the Unified Patent Court (UPC) has been busy.

- 53 cases are pending as of September 28, 2023;
- Three preliminary injunctions have been granted;
- Two inspections orders have been granted;
- Multiple oral hearings have taken place (Munich, Vienna, Helsinki); and
- At least 22 case management orders have been issued.
- More than 236 protective letters have been filed (as of June 26, 2023)

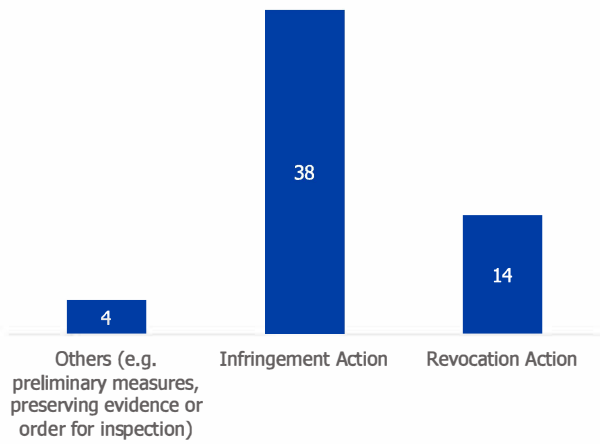

Where are the proceedings are held?

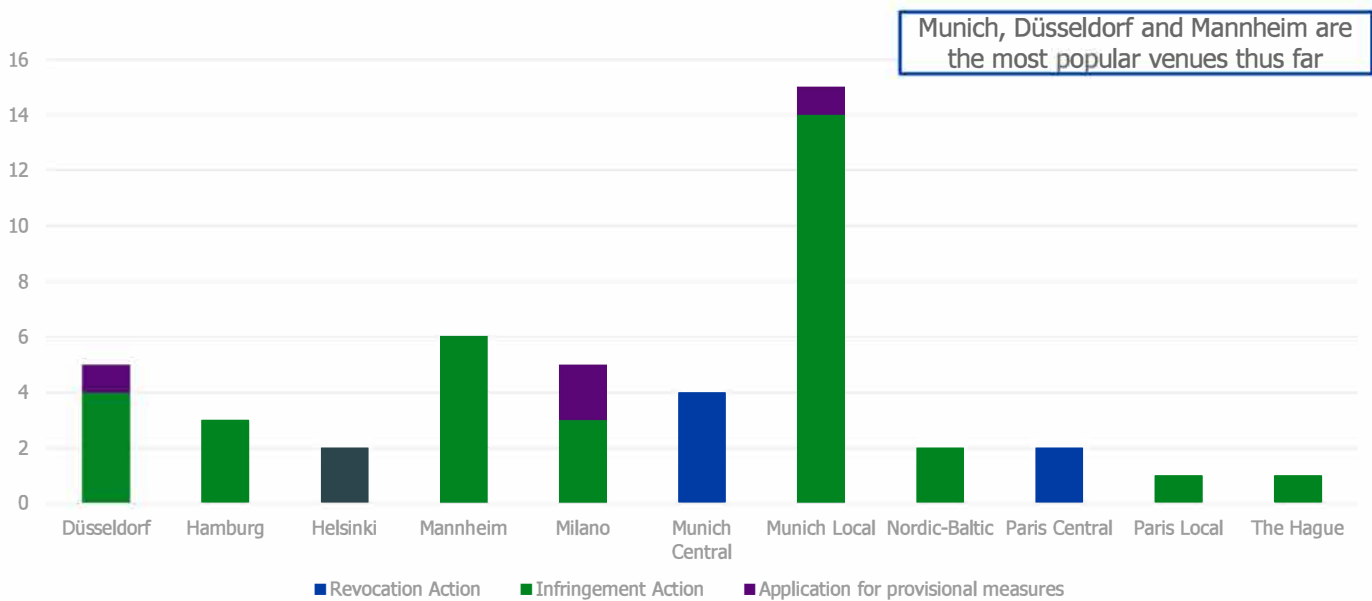
