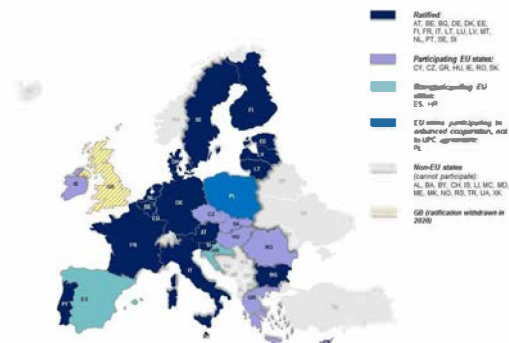

- On June 1st, system started in 17 EU Member States
- 7 signatory states (incl. IRL) likely to join later

Art. 34 UPCA

One single action will provide for an enforceable decision across the UPC states where EP has effect

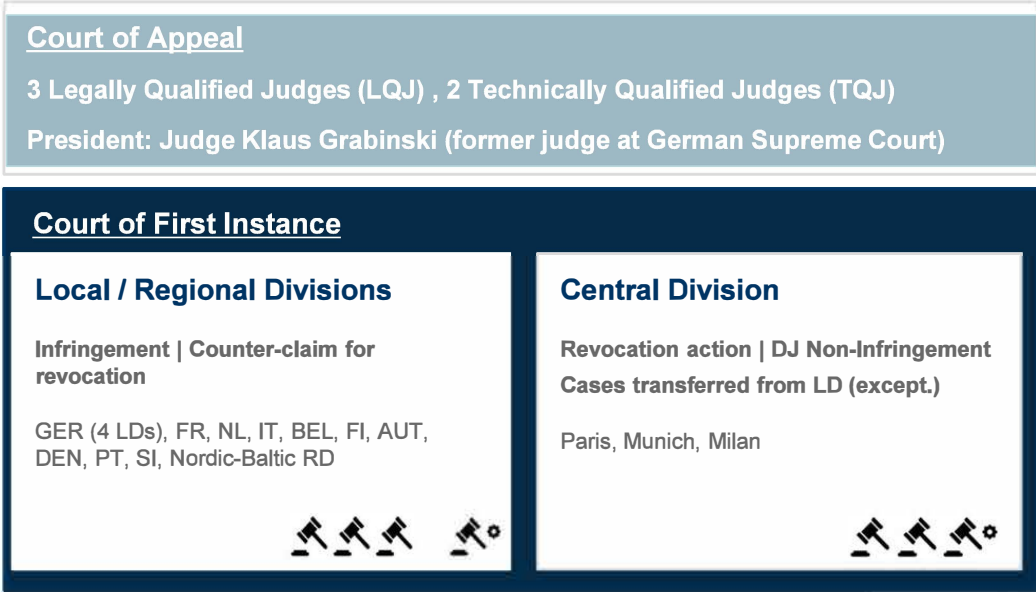

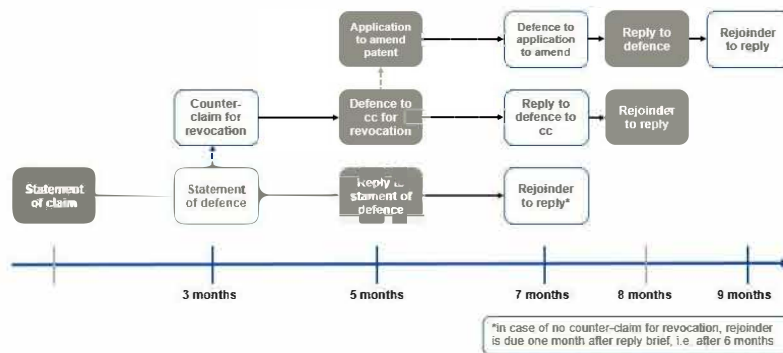

Late-filed submissions and facts may be disregarded (RoP 9.2)

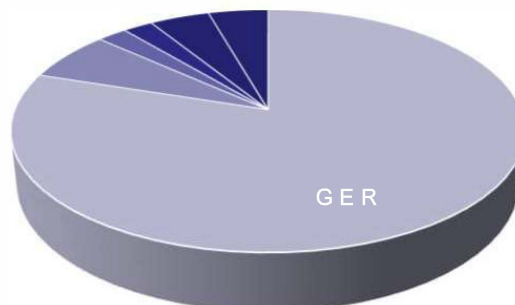
