Overview

- o All lease forms are not the same
 - o Office, Retail, Industrial, Ground
 - o While broadly similar, details are key
 - o Customized for industry and use
 - o Single-tenant, multi-tenant, industrial park
 - o Railroad, Port
- o Focus on manufacturing, service centers, work shops, repair centers, etc.

- o Some Special Uses in Oil & Gas Industry
 - o Test Well/Training Well
 - o Explosives or Radiation Bunker
 - o Chemical Storage
 - o Laboratories
 - o Offshore Base

Premises

- Description is not as critical as in office or retail leasing
- Often just focus on a legal description of the land
- Buildings may be extremely large, but relatively inexpensive
- Often it is more important to describe the supporting amenities such as docks, rail spurs, truck access, storage tanks, chemical storage, wash bays, etc.

Premises

- Consider special needs like rail and water frontage
- Confirm quantity and quality of utilities
- Confirm roads & driveways are suitable for weight of trucks
