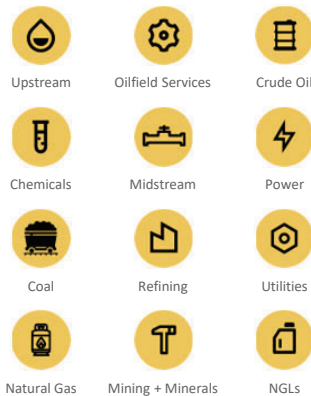

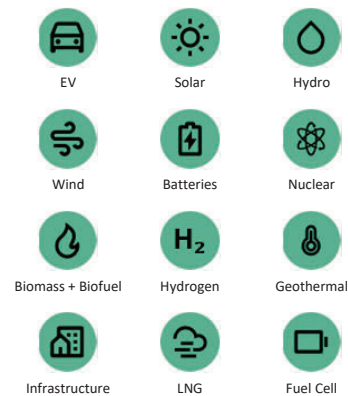

Energy Transition



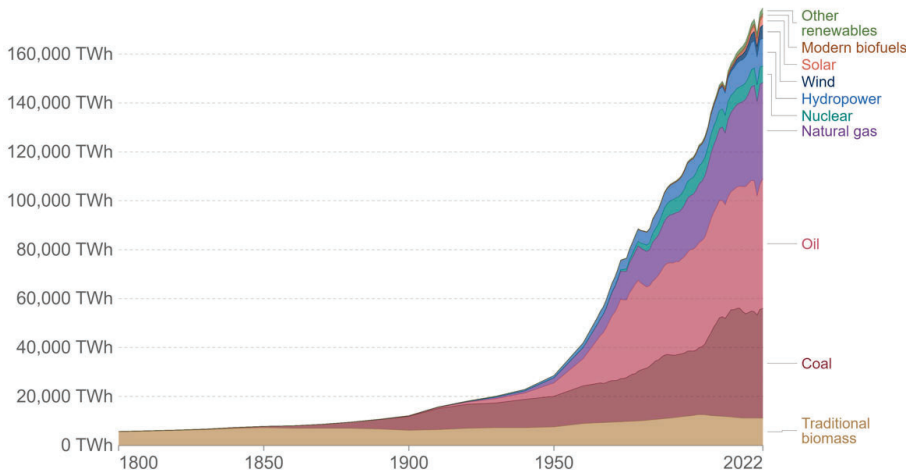

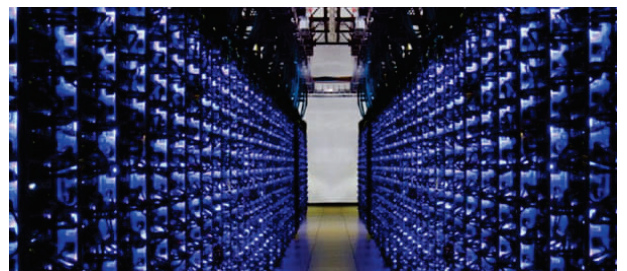
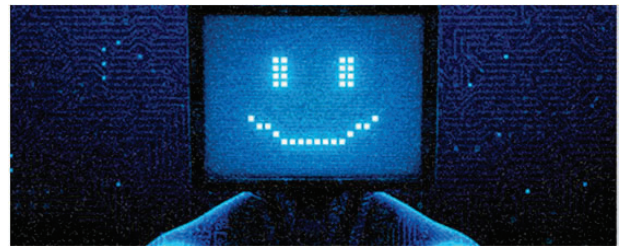
