#### Winter Storm Heather Update

- New winter peak demand record of 78,138 MW on Tuesday, January 16.
- Thermal generation accounted for 87% of energy during peaks on Monday-Tuesday
- Wind generation output: 1,900 MW to 24,400 MW.
- Solar generation output: 14,837 MW on Tuesday January 16, 2024 (all-time record).
- Battery Energy Storage Systems: 1,280 MW; 1.5% of total energy during peaks.
