- BUT WHY!?
- *Charitable Mission* - Resolved and/or changed.
- *Change in Economy/Lack of Resources*
- *Other Organizations*
- *Involuntary Termination* – Compliance/legal issues.



Dissolution

- **State Law Requirements**
 - Chapters 22 and 11 of TX Business Organizations Code
 - “Fundamental Action” – Voting and Notice Requirements
 - Plan of Distribution/Dissolution
 - State Filings – TX Form 652, *Certificate of Termination of a Domestic Nonprofit Corporation or Cooperative Association*

Dissolution

- **Other State Law Considerations**

- Additional Considerations (e.g., *Employees, etc.*)
- Attorney General Reqs (e.g., *Notice and/or Approval of Transaction*)
- Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (“UPMIFA”)
- Miscellaneous (e.g., *Charitable Registration, Permits, Licensing, etc.*)

 - Transfer of assets to Public Charity
 - Conversion to Public Charity
