






E-cigarettes - Legal Definition

- An electronic cigarette or any other device that simulates smoking by using a mechanical heating element, battery, or electronic circuit to deliver nicotine or other substances to the individual inhaling from the device.
- The term does not include a prescription medical device unrelated to the cessation of smoking.



E-Cigarettes Cont.

- Per the legal definition, any part of an e-cigarette, regardless of whether the components, part, or accessory is sold separately from the device, is considered an e-cigarette.
- A **vape** is considered an e-cigarette.
