- Related Legislative and Litigation Updates sprinkled in.

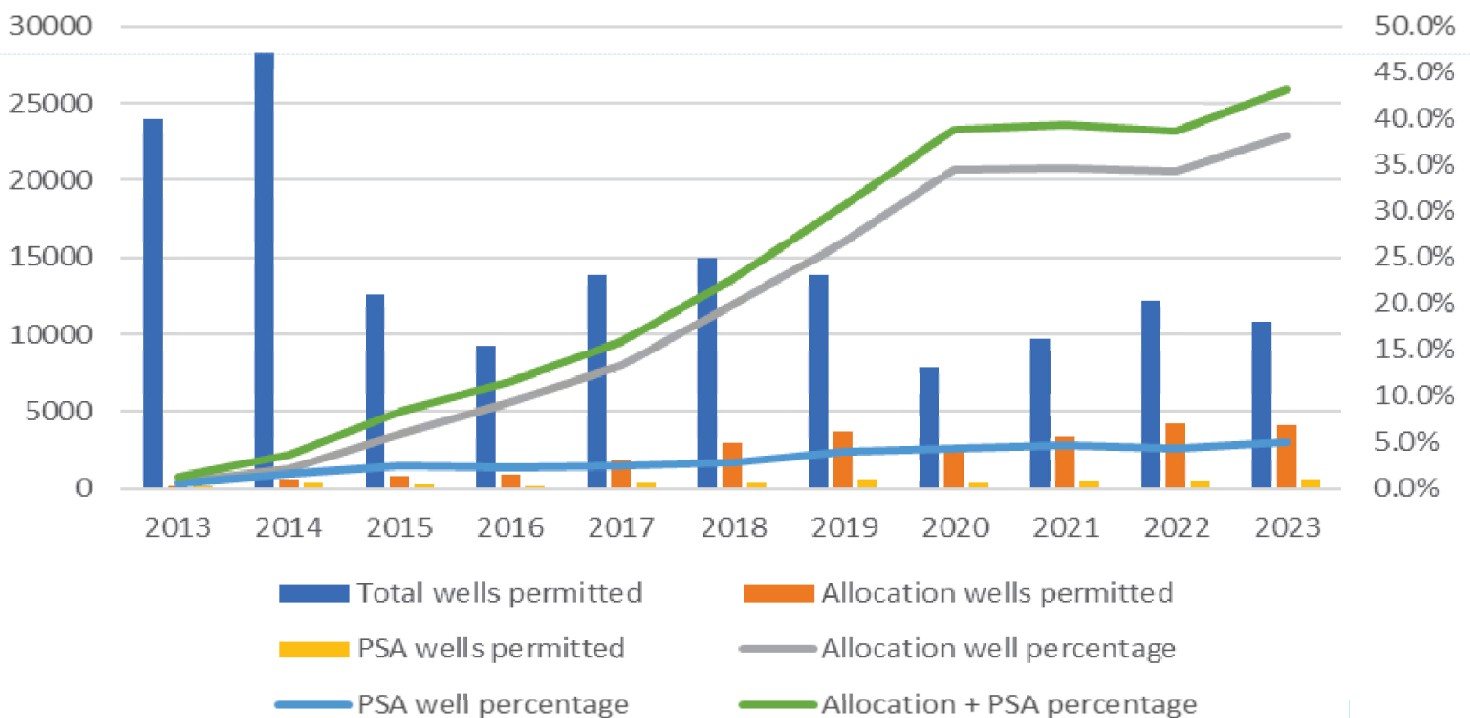
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# Allocation / PSA wells Update

- The percentage of wells permitted by the Railroad Commission as either Allocation wells or PSA wells has grown from 3.7% of all wells permitted in 2014 to 43.2% in 2023.

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# Allocation / PSA wells Update

- This data on allocation and PSA wells places in context the pending litigation in *R.R. Comm'n of Tex. v. Opiela*, 681 S.W.3d 397 (Tex. App.—Austin 2023, pet. filed).
- Disclosure: SDM represents the operator, Magnolia, in the *Opiela* case, along with Baker Botts, which joined for the appeal.

# Allocation / PSA wells Update

- Key issues in *Opiela* –
  - Pooling, RRC Rules, 65%
- Austin Court of Appeals
  - Not pooling, remand on 65% (dissent)
- Supreme Court
  - Parties' briefing the *Opiela*'s petition for review.
- No Allocation/PSA legislation introduced last session.

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
